	The course is usually a practical training at the animal field located on campus. During that period; students will have a rotational training at the poultry house, dairy cattle farm, and sheep farm. Training include all daily routine tasks from ration formulation to feeding, milking and weighing animals.	
	Student can choose the internship option, where the student spends the practical training semester in one or two locations approved and supervised by instructors. Student is required to submit weekly report of his training and activities for the period of 7 weeks. The student will have a supervisor in location who also submit a report of student progress and achievements during the training period. Feedback on progress in the course will be regularly provided to students to give them opportunities to improve their performance.
