Master dissertation topic: Attitudes and views of birth-spacing and contraceptive use among Arabic migrant women in Glasgow.

This dissertation carried out in Glasgow to explore the meaning that Arabic migrant women attach to birth-spacing/family planning and to identify their attitudes and practices regarding contraceptives use. The research design utilized qualitative semi-structured interview design. Permission and ethical approval to conduct the study were obtained from ethics committee of the School of Nursing, Midwifery and Community Health at Glasgow Caledonian University and Muslim Welfare House in Glasgow. The researcher uses purposive sampling technique to select the participants. The sample was six Arabic migrant women living in Glasgow were selected from the Muslim Welfare House in Glasgow (Dar Al-Muslimeen). With participant's consent, semi structured interview was conducted for data collection by the researcher; Interviews were audio-recorded by using multimedia player. The data was analysed using descriptive qualitative thematic analysis method. The researcher found that all the participants, although from different socio-demographical backgrounds, agreed that family planning is a positive thing and the majority of the participants considered family planning as fundamental to maintain women's health and to organize the family, thus an important social issue and one which is linked to family income. All of the participants agreed that the characteristics of a desirable contraceptive method include that it is effective, safe and practical. Also, the decision regarding family planning was jointly made by discussion between women and their husbands, although the practice of contraception was influenced by some religious beliefs, cultural beliefs and by the process of immigration. The unexpected finding in this study was that most of the participants' husbands preferred and used the male condom. Significantly most of the participants appeared and expressed their knowledge deficit regarding family planning. Despite some limitations of this study, the researcher concludes by recommending that special attention be directed to encourage strategies that will empower human being to obtain informed choice in relation to contraception use. Finally, further studies related to contraception would be valuable as a means of guiding informed future practice.
